

The Seven Sisters Tree Site Report APM April 2024

This Site was created in 2000 by a group of six Trustees and their families. Each Trustee family has an oak tree as a living memorial.

The seventh tree is dedicated to residents of Farthinghoe, where ashes of villagers may be scattered. A fee is charged. Stewardship membership is open to all at an annual subscription of £10.

A time capsule is buried at the site, to which children of the School in 2000 contributed along with other villagers.

During the last 2 years, sadly 2 of our original Trustees have died, namely Bud Mason, and John Deeley.
