This year there will be a Village Show on 1st September 2019 with a goal to bring the Village closer together.

1. Scarecrow Competition

Sometime in the week running up to the show we will have a scarecrow trail around the village on the theme of Nursery Rhymes.

2. Produce Competition

Three categories: Formal, comedy and children's.

The Formal category will be: Runner beans, Courgettes, Tomatoes, Beetroot, Onions, Squashes / pumpkins, Potatoes

To compete these can be presented separately or as a "Best presented medley".

The Comedy category will be "the most entertaining vegetable" - interpret that as you wish!

The Children's category can be a plant they have grown themselves, or a display of produce or flowers, shells etc - a miniature garden.

Fruit Category: Raspberries, Plums, Apples - cooking and eating, Grapes, Pears, Blackberries

Flower Category: Dahlias, Chrysanthemums, Misc blooms with theme (dazzling summer colour)

Jams and chutneys

Homemade liqueurs - to include fruit gins, vodkas, etc.

Cakes: Victoria sponges, Scones - fruit or plain

A Bake Off competition for the children - Children to decorate cup cakes against the clock, with all the usual pressures the programme offers.

More information on the format will follow each month, but get growing!

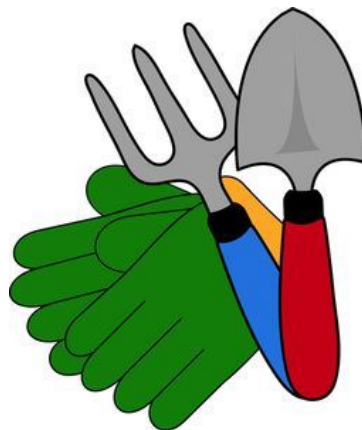
